Term: June - August 2019

Internship Description: Join our dynamic team as an intern this summer and build your professional skills on Bellingham Bay.

As an intern with the CBC, you will be able to apply your personal and professional experiences, and further your academic interests, through our marine stewardship, community outreach, and curriculum development opportunities. You'll serve approximately 20-40 hours per week alongside our operations, programs and fleet staffs providing high-quality customer service and experiences, and assisting to grow and enhance the CBC's offerings. Duties may include providing support with daily boat rentals, public education and engagement, and vessel and equipment repairs.

We have found that Outdoor Recreation, Environmental Studies, and other outdoor related majors are naturally suited to our internship positions, but all majors are welcome to apply.

It is a priority to the CBC that we offer our interns projects that enable you to grow toward your personal, professional and academic goals, while also developing key components of the CBC's mission.

Internship Qualifications:

- Washington State Boaters Safety Card (can be obtained after hire and before internship begins)
- Current CPR/First Aid/AED certification (can be obtained after hire and before internship begins)
- Enrolled in higher education
- Knowledge of and experience with sailing, kayaking, rowing or paddleboarding
- Desire to be active on the water
- Enjoy working with the public

Academic Development: Interns are required and supported to develop a study and work plan that ensures adequate time to develop and hone new skills in their given project. They are encouraged to incorporate complimentary business areas such as bookkeeping, social media, marketing, and administration.
